WORLD HANDICAP SYSTEM

It is nearly a year ago that the World Handicap System was introduced in Portugal. Regularly, questions surface indicating that an update on the most important matters may be needed.

- 1. You can register on **myfpg.pt**
 - to see what your exact handicap index is
 - what round you have played
 - to pre-register a general play round and enter the score for 9 or 18 holes
- 2. Your handicap index is calculated using the average of the best 8 score from the last 20 rounds recorded.
- 3. Handicaps no longer lapse unless you cease to be a member of at least one golf club.
- 4. There is no such thing as a nil return anymore If you fail to complete a round in a competition you still need to submit the card. Details on the holes that were completed will be entered into the system.
- 5. If you do not play in handicap qualifying competitions you are encouraged to submit general play cards in order to ensure that your handicap continues to reflect your ability.
- 6. Overseas members of clubs in a different country need to bring their handicap playing records when they come to Portugal for entry into the system here.
- 7. When overseas members leave to go home they should take their handicap playing record with them for entry into their handicap records in that country.
