REGULATION

Stroke-play, over two rounds
(one at Praia D'El Rey and one at West Cliffs)

Team event: Better-ball – two best net scores per hole
Professionals – Stroke-play

Handicaps – $\frac{3}{4}$ handicap, with slope adjustment

Tees:

- Professionals men– 62 at PDR and 59 at West Cliffs
- Amateurs men – 62 at PDR and 59 at West Cliffs
- Professionals ladies – 52 at PDR and 51 at West Cliffs
- Amateurs ladies – 52 at PDR and 51 at West Cliffs
- Exception – amateurs with 70 years or more are permitted to play from 57 at PDR and 55 at West Cliffs (mandatory to inform before playing)

Classification:

- Teams – Better ball net score, over two rounds
- Professionals – Two rounds, stroke-play

- Ties Professionals: In the event of a tie for 1st place, the lower score at West Cliffs will determine the winner. If the tie persists, the best last 9 holes at West Cliffs will determine the winner, followed by the last 6, last 3 and last hole. If the tie still persists, the winner will be decided by draw.

- Ties Teams: In the event of a tie for 1st place, the lower score at West Cliffs will determine the winner. If the tie persists, the team with the best last 9 holes at West Cliffs will determine the winner, followed by the last 6, last 3 and last hole. If the ties still persist, the team with highest average handicap will be the winner. This procedure will be used for all ties.

Note: Hole # 12 at PDR will be played as a par 4. The stroke index of hole # 10 will be 11 and from hole # 12, 7.
